PARISH UPDATES

There will be a PRO-LIFE Rosary every 2nd Sunday of the month at 9 in the morning before the Mass.



PREP Spring Break will start on Friday, March 15, and classes will resume on Thursday, April 4.

In anticipation of the 99th founding anniversary of St. Joseph's Parish, we will start the nine-day novena to St. Joseph:

- Legion of Mary** March 13 (Wednesday)
- Media** March 14 (Thursday)
- Ushers** March 15 (Friday)
- Saturday Choir/Lectors** March 16 (Saturday) at 5:00pm
- Sunday Lectors** March 17 (Sunday) at 9:00am
- Couples for Christ** March 18 (Monday)

All weekday novena will be at 6:30 PM. Also, during the weekdays, the Mass will be at 7 PM; there will be NO weekday Mass at 9:30 AM except on March 15 (Friday), Mass will also be at 9:30 AM followed by Eucharistic Adoration at 10 AM. Since March 15 (Friday) is both a Stations of the Cross and St. Joseph's novena day, the Stations of the Cross will begin at 6 PM followed by the novena at 6:30 PM.



For St. Joseph's Feast day, on March 19 (Tuesday), the Mass will be at 6 PM followed by a potluck dinner after the Mass. There will be a sign-up sheet for volunteers to help in the setup, cleanup, food preparation, etc., and what dish to bring.
