All weekday novena will be at 6:30 PM. Also, during the weekdays, the Mass will be at 7 PM; there will be NO weekday Mass at 9:30 AM except on March 15 (Friday), Mass will also be at 9:30 AM followed by Eucharistic Adoration at 10 AM. Since March 15 (Friday) is both a Stations of the Cross and St. Joseph's novena day, the Stations of the Cross will begin at 6 PM followed by the novena at 6:30 PM.



For St. Joseph's Feast day, on March 19 (Tuesday), the Mass will be at 6 PM followed by a potluck dinner after the Mass. There will be a signup sheet for volunteers to help in the setup, cleanup, food preparation, etc., and what dish to bring.




