Pouring rain on a Sunday night in Whistler, it felt warm as a small group of delegates from St. Joseph's Parish witnessed and listened intently to one of the greatest speakers of our time, Fr. John Riccardo.

His presentation is just a glimpse of his apostolate, Acts XXIX, yet so powerful. How did he come up with this name? Acts 29? We wondered. Let's read what he stated.

"The Acts of the Apostles in the Bible has only 28 chapters. So what happens in the next chapter? Chapter 29 is you do. The point is You. The same Holy Spirit who was writing before is writing right now. You are. I am. We are the next chapter of our church. He's not done yet. He created each and everyone of us to be alive in this moment in history not in any other time. You just don't happen to be alive right now. You are alive in this moment, in this place, for a purpose. That is what Acts XXIX means. That is the name of our apostolate. It is the name of us, our church.

In the western world and this area in Canada, people think that the church is in decline. The numbers are pretty bad. If it is true, God is not anxious as He looks in the world. He is not nervous. Our favourite Psalm 46:10 states "Be still and know that I am God". Relax, it's okay. If we understand who God is and the plan He has for us, this is the obvious challenge to all of us."
